Shop for COBYS at Park City on April 26

If you have some shopping to do, Saturday, April 26, would be a good day to do it. COBYS Family Services is participating in the Shop for a Cause Expo at Park City

Center in Lancaster from 10 a.m. to 9:30 p.m. that day.

The event is sponsored by the Lancaster Hempfield Rotary Club, which will be providing prize money. Here's how it works: For every dollar you spend at a Park City Center retailer or restaurant on April 26, you can assign one point to the non-profit of your choice.



Of course, we hope that you will choose COBYS. Awards of \$3,000, \$2,500, \$2,000, and \$1,500 will be presented to the four organizations with the highest number of points. (Thirty-eight organizations are participating.)



When you are done shopping or having lunch or dinner at one of the mall restaurants, simply bring receipts from all of your purchases to the Lancaster Hempfield Rotary Club Information Booth in the center of the mall and designate your points for COBYS. While you are at the Rotary booth, you can earn 100 additional points by donating groceries worth \$5 or more or by making a \$5 donation to the Hempfield Food Pantry.

If you visit 10 or more booths, you earn an additional 100 points and also make yourself eligible to win one of two Kindle Fire tablet computers and other prizes. (Pick up a card at the Rotary booth to document booths visited.) We hope one of the booths you visit will be ours. We'll be located in the Bon Ton wing.
