2014 Bike & Hike Aims for \$110,000

After eclipsing the \$100,000 mark for the first time in 2013, we're back at it, planning for a bigger and better Bike & Hike in 2014. New this year is a silent auction (see p. 2).



The Bike & Hike is slated for Sunday, September 7, at the <u>Lititz Church of the</u> <u>Brethren</u>, 300 W. Orange St., Lititz. Goals of 600 participants and \$110,000 have been set. Last year 538 participants raised more than \$104,000. Proceeds benefit COBYS ministries to children and families.

The Bike & Hike consists of a three-mile walk, 10- and 25-mile bicycle rides, and the 65-mile Dutch Country Motorcycle Ride. Participants choose their event, and then donate a registration fee, raise money from sponsors, or some of both. At the conclusion of the event, everyone gathers on the grounds at Lititz Church of

the Brethren for refreshments, fellowship, and prizes as we celebrate the outpouring of giving and thank participants and sponsors. Youth groups who raise \$1,500 or more earn a gym and pizza night.

Business sponsors have committed nearly \$20,000 so far. The Event Sponsor is Cocalico

between Manheim and Lititz. Children age 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

The more challenging <u>25-mile route</u> includes some of Lancaster County's finest scenery and some moderate hills. A drink and fruit stop is provided.

This year's motorcycle ride travels north along some of Lancaster, Lebanon, and western Berks County's scenic roads. Sights include the Middle Creek Wildlife Management Area, historic churches and meetinghouses, beautiful farmland, and more. Included is a break stop at



Camp Swatara's Family Camping Area.

Considering Foster Care or Adoption?

Are you considering God's call to care for children through foster care or adoption? Attending a Resource Family Orientation Session is a great way to explore that call. COBYS offers monthly orientations at the COBYS main office, 1417 Oregon Road, Leola, and at the Wyomissing Church of the Brethren, 2200 State Hill Rd, Wyomissing.

Orientations are designed for families who want to learn more about <u>infant adoption</u>, <u>foster care</u>, or <u>adoption through foster care</u>. During a two-hour session, families receive an introduction to the roles, expectations, and approval process for COBYS resource families. The orientation is free and places no obligation on those attending. Child care is not provided.
