Sigman, Taylors to **Headline Praise Dinner**

Speaker Mike Sigman and gospel artists The Taylors will provide inspiration and entertainment at the 21st annual Wenger Foundation Praise Dinner on Thursday, April 21, at 6:00 p.m., at the Lebanon Expo Center. The event will benefit COBYS Family Services and three other ministries.



Sigman is the Lead Pastor at Grace Community Church in Lancaster, a frequent preacher at area churches and camp meetings, and past president of **Evangelical Seminary in** Myerstown.

The Taylors are a nationally



known brothersister quartet from North Carolina. In 2008, The Taylors won first place in the Talent Showcase

of the National Quartet Convention in Louisville, Kentucky.

The Praise Dinner will include a buffet meal catered by Country Home Catering. Other ministries benefitting from the event are Evangelical Seminary, Friendship Community, and On Fire Youth Ministries.

The cost to attend is \$125 per person or \$1,250 per table of 10 guests. All donations support the designated ministries, as The Wenger Foundation and other business partners underwrite all expenses.

Last year's Praise Dinner attracted some 850 people, and raised more than \$130,000, including \$26,038 for COBYS. Since 1999 COBYS has received more than \$331,000 through the Praise Dinner.

Seating for each banquet is limited to 450 (a reduction of 100 from previous years). If both time slots fit your schedule, we encourage you to choose the daytime event. Your chances of getting a good seat are higher at noon, and we are anticipating possible over-booking for the evening. We'll have the same delicious



food and an inspirational, informative, and entertaining program each time.

Reservations are required, and the event will include an opportunity to support COBYS ministries. Guests may reserve a table of eight for \$300 or a table of 12 for \$450. Individuals or couples also may attend without reserving a table and give as they feel led at the event. Those not at purchased tables will be assigned seating at unreserved tables.
