It's Back: Give Nov. 22 to Earn a Match

The first ever 24-hour online giving campaign sponsored last November by the Lancaster County Community Foundation was so successful that the Foundation is doing it again. And so is COBYS.

This year's ExtraOrdinary Give is slated for Friday, November 22. <u>More than</u> <u>250 non-profit organizations</u> are participating. The logistics are the same as last year. With credit card in hand, donors simply need to visit <u>extragive.org</u> between 12:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on Friday, November 22, choose COBYS from the list

of organizations, and give a donation of \$25 or more

The Foundation, with help from Presenting Sponsor Rodgers & Associates, is promoting the event, providing prize money, and offering a \$250,000 "stretch fund" that will be divided proportionately among participating organizations. The more our donors give, the greater COBYS' proportion of the \$250,000. For example, if a total of \$2 million dollars is given to all organizations and COBYS receives \$40,000 from its donors, we receive two percent or \$5,000 of the match.

On top of the match, an additional \$50,000 will be awarded in prizes. During certain time periods, individual donations will be randomly selected. If a COBYS donor is chosen, the foundation will add \$1,000 to that donation. The more individual donations COBYS receives, the greater our chance of winning one or more prizes.

Last year COBYS had the fifth highest donation total of 192 organizations and earned a \$1,000 Early Bird prize for being the second organization to reach 50 "unique donors." COBYS' net income for the day exceeded \$32,500. (A unique donor is one person giving with one credit card. A husband and wife can give two "unique donations" if they use two different credit cards.)

"Now that people know how this works," says COBYS Director of Development Don Fitzkee, "we think the competition will be tougher this year. If we're going to win the Early Bird prize this time around, it probably will take some night owls to give at the stroke of midnight."

Please mark your calendar, tell your friends, and remember COBYS on November 22. Additional information will be mailed to COBYS supporters with a year-end appeal letter next week.
