Choosing to Parent

For those who choose to parent their child, COBYS birth parent counselors:

- offer practical and emotional support before and after the birth;
- help identify and develop a network of people and resources to support you in your role as a parent;
- connect new parents to COBYS family life education programs.

Choosing Adoption

For those who choose to make an adoption plan, COBYS birth parent counselors:

- provide scrapbooks of approved adoptive families to help birth parents select the right family for their child;
- help birth parents to discern how open their adoption will be;
- assist in making plans for the day of delivery; and
- prepare birth parents for the grief and loss associated with placing a child for adoption.



Openness in Adoption

In most circumstances open adoption is beneficial for the birth family, adoptive family and, most importantly, the adopted child. COBYS works with birth parents and adoptive families to determine what level of openness is appropriate for their specific situation. Examples of openness can include meeting the adoptive family, receiving photographs from adoptive parents, providing your medical history to adoptive parents, exchanging e-mails, and ongoing contact as the child grows.
